ROYAL COPENHAGEN PORCELAIN ADDS THE LHASA APSO TO ITS COLLECTION

I'm sure you're all familiar with the lovely figurines manufactured by the Royal Copenhagen Porcelain Manufactory - those exquisite hand finished pieces of children, birds, animals, plates, vases and plaques with the three blue wavy lines as the trademark.

Well, last year they decided to add the Lhasa Apso to their collection of 13 or so dogs. And they chose, as the model, Rag-Pa van de Warwinkel, owned by Hanne Moeller-Jensen of Denmark and bred by Annie J. C. Schneider-Louter.

At the top is Rag-Pa with the sculptor in her studio. I'm sorry we don't have her name.

And here is Hanne, Rag-Pa and the sculptor in the company's showrooms.
